

CPE NATIONALS AT WAG CAMPING INFO. AND RESERVATION REQUEST FORM

The reservation form at the end of this document will be available for those that wish to request onsite camping space at WAG for the CPE Nationals. As interest in camping onsite is high we expect a draw for camping spots will be required. This form is the only way to request a camping spot for Nationals at WAG and it must be completed **clearly and completely**. Incomplete forms or those without enclosed funds for the reservation will be set outside of the draw. Make sure your form is correct and payment is included before you send it in.

This form will be accepted at WAG or through the mail arriving no sooner than March 14th - through postmark or hand delivered date of March 20th to be considered and included in the draw. Camping spots will be assigned on March 27th and participants that were given a camping spot will be notified by email with a confirmation of camping and their assigned spot or that they did not receive a spot to camp onsite as ALL spots were filled. If you wish to camp in the area and do not get a spot on site - please see RV locations in the area under "area accommodations"

DO NOT send in a request with the everyday RV form on our website - that form will not cover the Nationals - costs and options are different and your form will be rejected. You must utilize this RV form only.

Camping space at WAG will be available to request for the following dates – Thursday May 18th – through Sunday May 21st. Arrival on Thursday for campers will begin at 8 AM. Wednesday PM Arrival on May 17th (between 5-7 pm will be allowed – but power hookups may not be available) Those interested in Wednesday evening arrival – email in advance. Those staying over on Sunday night must vacate by 10AM Monday morning. (Sunday night campers hooked up to generators – will have generator service till 10PM Sunday evening only. No service Monday AM.) Requests for camping spots staying 3 to 5 nights will take priority over fewer nights.

RV Camping with electric and electric/water hookups (no sewer service is available) \$40.00 per day RV Camping space without power \$20 per day – Tent/Car campers \$15.00 for the weekend. Dry camping in a car/van is allowed so long as you do not take up a larger than normal passenger vehicle spot. You must still send in the form to be allowed to stay on site overnight. There will be an outdoor shower available on site.

All RV request forms must include the correct rental fee. Please make all checks payable to WAG, Inc.

Important Notes



There are 21 spaces with 30 amp service (generator powered) as noted number 4 on the map. There will also be 12 more spaces with 20 amp service (generator powered) as noted area 16 on the map. We also have a smaller number of full time 20 and 30 amp electric spots at the barns. Area 10,12 and 2C. RV dry camping will also be an option along area 16A. Approx.. 7 spots.

Electric in the back rows is supplied by generators only and will be shut off from 10PM till 6AM to provide quiet time for all – please plan accordingly.

As the draw for camping spots is pulled we will fill each available spot based on what you requested. first if available and then any option you are willing to take if your first choice is not available. So, it will be VERY IMPORTANT that you fill in your form completely. If there are no options either size or power wise for you to camp – you also will have the opportunity to be added to a wait list should someone cancel from a spot that would fit your needs.

<u>Campers/Trailers</u> - when you arrive please park carefully as to not damage buildings, fences or small trees. All trailers in parking area 4 or 16 must unhook their tow vehicle and park it in a designated parking spot. Campers in area 4 or 16 may not setup ez-ups on the side of their unit as it will take up another person's RV space. Canopies can be located closer into the ring and beyond the water/power supplies. The lawn where the standard rings will be used area 15 is not an off leash area at any time for campers – even after hours.

<u>**Car - Small Van camping</u>**. If you are car/van camping your vehicle must fit within a normal 9x18 parking spot and nothing can extend or protrude outside of that area.</u>

<u>**Tenters**</u> – will have a designated spot assigned for them on the south side of area 15. There is no parking next to the tenting area. You will be allowed to unload at the tenting area and then will need to move your vehicle to a regular parking space.

<u>RV Dumping Service</u> – if there is enough interest for a possible service for RV's/Trailers to have them dumped on Saturday – we may arrange for that. Be sure to check that on your RV form if you feel you would be interested. The servicing company charges \$50 per unit to be dumped and fees would be collected in advance of ordering of the service.

<u>Parking Passes</u> – all vehicles coming to Nationals must have a parking pass with them and visible in their main vehicle. The parking pass will be included at no additional charge for those with confirmed camping reservations. Your parking pass will be identified by the type of camping reservation you have. Parking passes will be issued early May. **RV's bringing in a tow vehicle – will need to apply for a parking permit for that vehicle – cost is \$7 and can be purchased on the main site when available.**

<u>**RV's** – Large Conversion Vans</u>. If you are attending the Nationals and plan to drive in with a vehicle that does not have a camping reservation nor fit into a regular 9x18 parking spot – you will be allowed to drop off ring side any items you wish and then will be required to park in the overflow parking area as listed on the map. No vehicles may dry camp in this area.

Camping fees are non-refundable if your reservation is cancelled 7 days or less prior to event. You must provide a fully completed form and clearly written/typed email address and contact number in order to be confirmed for camping. Please read your emailed confirmation carefully once you receive it and bring it with you as well as the facility map to help located your spot once you arrive.
