# **Running order for both days:**

<u>Ring 1</u>- Novice & Adv. Standard/Regular - Nested in same ring – height order determined by entries. <u>Ring 2</u>- Novice & Adv. Jumpers – Nested in the same ring - height order determined by entries. Followed by Tunnelers (Sunday only)

### DIRECTIONS TO WAG, Inc. (Western Agility Group) 10925 Bruceville Road in Elk Grove:

From Hwy 5 to Elk Grove. Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit and go East. Turn right on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd. Follow driveway to the rear. There will be a sign by the fence and the road is marked "Fritz's Teeter Trail".

From Hwy 99 to Elk Grove. Take the Elk Grove Blvd exit and go West. Turn left on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd, follow driveway to rear. There will be a sign by the fence and the road is marked "Fritz's Teeter Trail".

## CHECK IN: 8:00 AM FIRST RUNS START PROMPLTY AT: 9:00 AM



Unless we have inclement weather – the inside covered ring on dirt will have the Standard Course & the outside lawn will have Jumpers & Tunnelers (Sunday). If we have bad weather the large fenced indoor arena will be separated into two rings and everything will be inside.

### AGILITY FUN MATCH INFORMATION

This **event is designed** to prepare both handlers and dogs for actual trialing. If you have been through agility classes, but are not quite ready to trial, this is an excellent chance for you to prepare for competition. We ask that you have at least six full months of weekly training classes and that you participate with the concurrence of your instructor. Runs may be timed and each run may be limited to a maximum of 75 seconds for Standard/Regular and 60 Seconds for Jumpers and Tunnelers. Total time may vary based on entries. No awards or placements will be given. This is not for competition, but for fun, experience, & practice. Treats & toys in the ring are encouraged, & praising your dog is mandatory. Dogs must be able to do all pieces of equipment safely & must be under control both in & out of the ring. Harsh corrections, either physical or verbal, will not be tolerated.

**Jump height and Age** – Jump height is at your discretion (we suggest you jump the height you practice in class). Dogs must be at least One year old

What are nested courses? Nested courses are a way of combining courses together to make an event run smoother and faster. You will find that each of the Standard/Regular and Jumpers courses have both a Novice and an Advanced level course built into one course. We recommend that folks only try the advanced course if you are already competing and that you plan on utilizing the Novice course if this is your first fun match. The Novice course in both rings will be numbered with orange cones. You will have other options to utilize your run time as well. Often exhibitors work contacts, weaves and start lines as their main objective. More details on all of these options will be discussed at the briefing each morning and we'll answer all questions then too.


<u>TUNNELERS AGILITY RUNS</u> – Tunnelers is a short agility course which consists of tunnels only – you'll be running with your dog (off lead only) to finish as quickly as you can the sequence laid out. Offered on Sunday after regular runs only. There will be only one Tunnelers course – but you can enter it multiple times.

Dogs cannot run on a leash in the fun match, & only flat buckle collars (no tags, tabs) are allowed in the



ring. Confirmations – if requested will be sent by email – please be sure to carefully print your email address & double check it for accuracy or we will not be able to send you a confirmation. They may not be sent out immediately upon receipt – but will go out prior to the event to confirm entry into the match.

The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the event, regardless of the reason for dismissal. It is expressly understood



that entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children, or guests. Any entrant whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, or guests from the event grounds. No refund of fees will be made in such a case. Judge and/or gate steward may excuse team for any infractions with NO REFUNDS.



This match will be limited – however we will allow day of match entries until the limit is reached if not full before the match date. You may verify status of the fun match by emailing the match secretary at Susan@k9wag.com up until 12PM on Friday October 25th to see if there is still room available for day of entries or check the website at www.k9wag.com if the fun match fills there will be a note with that information online.

Check-in will begin at 8:00 AM, with handler briefing and walk throughs shortly after and we plan to start first runs by 9:00 AM, so if you don't pre-enter, please get there early or you may get left out! Entries may not be canceled, changed or altered after the closing date. Set up area under the covered arena is not unlimited, so bring canopies just in case.
