

**BRIEFING**: The table is live at all times after you receive the "Go."

All obstacles may be taken twice for points and back to back obstacles are allowed if done safely.

To qualify, you must obtain the required obstacles, which are three (3) 1 point obstacles, two (2) 3 point obstacles and one (1) 5 point obstacle and the additional points to complete your level.

Once you complete your point accumulation, you may go to the table at any time. Once the horn blows, you have 5 seconds for your dog to touch the table to stop the clock, or lose one point per full second over time

1 Point: Single bar jumps

3 Point: Tunnels, Panel


5 Point Jokers: Combo, Double, Weaves


Times: Large Dogs: 30 seconds; Small Dogs: 35 seconds; 16" vets jumping 12" get big Dog time.







Opening -

- All obstacles are bi-directional

- Combos (5a/5b and 7a/7b) can be done in any order
- When using #7a as a red, only need to do the jump
- #4 and #7a can be used as a red one time each
- Reds can only be used one time each; numbered obstacles can be used multiple times
- 4th red is available if dog knocks a bar on a red

## Closing -

- #2 is bi-directional

 Finish jump becomes live when you have completed your opening, after the horn or when you direct your dog to it. Finish jump is bi-directional and there is no fault for knocking the bar.

Small dog time - 55 seconds Big dog time - 50 seconds
