NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

*The safety of the dogs is the primary concern so by entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the trial site, then the exhibitor will not be refunded any fees that have been paid.

*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

*Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Any illegible or incomplete entries will not be entered in the trial.

A general briefing, as well as the judge's briefing notes, will be sent via email. Course maps for each trial day will be emailed the evening before each trial day. Run orders will be posted in multiple locations at the facility. Neither the judge nor host club are required to provide details of the general briefing once it has been sent.		
<u>** We are offering Double Down for Jumpers on Sunday. You must enter the first round to enter the Double Down run. Double Down is the ability to re-run the designated course above again, no re-walk, course will be the same. **</u>		
ALL DOGS THAT NEED TO BE MEASURED MUST GET IT DONE PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST RUN - NO EXCEPTIONS (the best time to do this is before runs start as the judge has limited time availability.)		
NOTE: Height cards with an actual measurement, from another Agility Venue, may now be used in lieu of a measurement at a CPE trial.		

**EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG
AT THE TRIAL SITE AND HOTELS!
ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA.**

There is some room under cover for set ups - bring shelter for setups outside, along with x-pens, crates, & chairs. Email confirmations will be sent upon receipt and processing of your entry— please review your confirmation carefully and send any corrections in immediately. Retain your confirmation and bring it along to the show. **Any changes made at the trial, due to not checking your confirmation, will cost \$10.**

AWARDS AND PRIZES

Ribbons for all qualifying scores will be awarded. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd placements. Dogs with NT [no time] are not eligible for any awards.



WAG FACILITY RULES

All exhibitors are subject to ejection for failure to comply.

1. Respect all the grounds - pick up after your dog at all times- everywhere on the property. Please pick up all your trash and dispose of properly. Do not allow your dogs to urinate anywhere on the buildings, garbage cans, or planters.
2. Obey all speed and parking signs. Driveway speed is 5MPH and will be enforced.
3. Be aware of your dog and your immediate surroundings. Dog aggression will not be tolerated No dog may be left tied up unattended - at any time.
4. Respect the agility equipment and all of the facility buildings. Do not use equipment not in use by club.
5. If there are problems/issues with the facility, please inform a club member and/or the facility owners.
6. All children must be supervised at all times.
